

Classroom 2

We learned about author Study and Earth Science. The author we choose was Eric Carle. Children loved to do finger paint and make some collages like Eric Carle. Their favorite book was "The Very Lonely Firefly" and they enjoyed to make the puzzle that was called "Our Solar System".

We are going to learn about Winter/Snow/ Winter Animals. Our Book is "The Snow Day" by Ezra Jack Keats and our STEM topic will be Physical Science.

We are going to talk about snow, winter and clothes, and asked children to draw their favorite winter animal.

Classroom 3

Kitchen Helpers- we invited children into the kitchen during this Holiday Season. We learned about simple measurements, cooking tools and utensils, and kitchen safety. Children will use their senses as they discover new tastes, textures, scents, colors, and more. We made Chocolate Snowball and they loved it.
